

> Where is free parking available?

Most on-street parking in the downtown area is free, short-term parking. Longer duration free parking options are available on streets further away from downtown.

> Can I park in a free parking space overnight?

Most of downtown's free parking spaces do not allow parking between 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. Permit parking spaces may represent a good option in those cases.

Downtown also offers **accessible parking**.

Anyone can use these spaces with the proper state-approved permit. Please note that some of these spaces may have certain time restrictions.

Downtown also has a few limited areas of **leased** or **reserved parking**. These spaces are assigned to specific people or businesses. Enforcement of these spaces, including towing, may occur outside of normal business hours.

The guidelines and pictures shown are representatives of typical conditions. Please consult signage (in and entering lots) for the precise parking requirements. 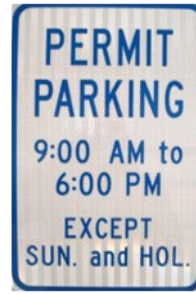


DOWNTOWN PARKING CITY OF OSHKOSH

If what's "happening now" brings you downtown, then we want to help you understand your options for on-street and off-street parking.

Downtown has two primary types of parking: permit parking and free, short-term parking.

- Permit parking can provide you with a lot of flexibility if you come downtown frequently or spend a long time there. As part of the permit parking the City of Oshkosh offers **daily parking permits** which work nicely for those who would like to stay downtown for a longer period of time.
- Free parking options work well for customers or visitors who will stay only a short time.



Permit parking spots are indicated by blue-lettered signage. To use one of these spaces, you will need to have a daily permit, a monthly sticker or an annual sticker.

> What types of permits are there, and how much do they cost?

Monthly and annual stickers are currently available from the Collections office at City Hall at the rate of \$20/month or \$210/year, respectively. Discounts are available for customers who buy a minimum number of permits. For your convenience, you may pre-pay for several months of monthly stickers. Undated **daily permits** are available at the Collections office and Oshkosh Public Library. The base price is \$1.50 per day, with discounts available for bulk purchases.

> How do I use a permit? Stickers should be attached to vehicles according to the instructions. Daily permits are pre-numbered pieces of cardstock paper, which should be placed on the dashboard of the vehicle, and marked with the date of use.

> Where is the permit parking available?

Most permit spaces are located in off-street parking lots. The spaces are indicated by signage.

> When do I need to use a permit?

Most permit parking spaces are enforced between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. every day except Sundays and holidays. Vehicles may generally park in a permit space overnight (between 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.) without needing a permit.

> Does a permit reserve a particular parking space?

Permits allow you to park in any permit parking space, giving you the flexibility to park at different locations based on what best meets your needs and where parking is available.



Free, short term parking spaces are generally available on-street and in many downtown lots, typically for up to 90 minutes or 2 hours.

> Who can use these spaces? There are no restrictions on who can use these spaces. If you are an employee or property owner, keep these spaces available as a courtesy to customers.
