Holiday Parade Guidelines

Please make sure all parties in your unit are aware of the following information:

A copy of the official parade staging map was sent out via email, but also can be found at www.downtownoshkosh.com
The parade route will begin on Ceape/Main St. & head North until Irving/Main St.
Staging is NOT in chronological order. Please understand due to space & safety concerns, you will not necessarily follow the unit in front of you. The actual parade lineup is in chronological
order; please know who you are following.
Because of television coverage there will be NO stopping by any unit along the parade route; all units MUST keep moving.
All floats are to exit either east or west on Irving Ave or keep heading north on N Main St. Please keep moving out of the way to avoid backup.
Units are NOT to throw candy, paper handouts, etc. This is a safety precaution, as we do not want kids running out into the street. However, you may hand them materials.
NO unit may have a Santa appear on their float other than the Santa Carriage as the finale of the parade.

Final note – please be conscientious of your staging area and clean up after your group.
